SAFE TRAVEL CHECKLIST for Students

No matter how you travel to and from school, keep these three tips in mind to help everyone stay safe.





Stay socially distanced whenever possible, including as you enter and leave the school building.



Wash your hands before leaving home and once you arrive at school.



When traveling to and from school on the

SCHOOL BUS

- Stand at least six feet apart while waiting at the bus stop and wear your mask when waiting with others you do not live with.
- If you don't have a mask, ask your bus driver for one.
- Follow directions from your bus driver or other staff member about how to load/unload and where to sit on the bus.
- Face forward (with your mask on) and avoid turning around to speak to those behind you once you're seated.



When traveling to and from school on

PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION

- Always wear your mask at the bus stop and while riding, even if others aren't wearing one.
- Stand six feet apart from others (except those you live with) while you are waiting for the bus.
- Try to stay six feet apart from others while getting on and off the bus.



When traveling to and from school in a

PRIVATE VEHICLE

- Put your mask on before you exit the car.
- When being picked up, keep your mask on until you are in the vehicle.
- Be familiar with and follow your school's recommendations for safe drop-off and pick-up locations.

When traveling to and from school by WALKING

- Wear your mask when walking with others you do not live with.
- Avoid walking in large groups.
